For example, in the last year, your alumni association has celebrated the success of students, graduates, faculty, and administrators. We have also encouraged students and their families in a variety of ways.

The Alumni Association:

Beech Grove High School Alumni Association's 2024 Teacher of the Year Mary Beth (Flanders) Wolfe

Mary Beth (Flanders) Wolfe was born to Jim and Judy Flanders on November 20, 1966. "Beth" attended Beech Grove City Schools for all of her schooling and graduated from Beech Grove High School in 1985. Beth was deeply influenced by her parents and her father was her principal when she attended BGMS as a student. She assisted her mother occasionally at Beech Tree House Center for Child Development when she was in middle school. She attended the University of Indianapolis, known as Indiana Central University at that time, and earned her Bachelor's degree in 1989 in elementary education with endorsements in both mathematics and English. Beth waited tables during high school and college to help pay for her education. She later attended IUPUI and earned her Master's degree in 1993.

Beth began her teaching career at Fulton Junior High School in Wayne Township in the fall of 1989 where she taught for 10 years. She coached the Future Problem Solving team and The Odyssey of the Mind teams. She was also the school improvement coordinator and hosted several student teachers. During this time, she also taught college Algebra and college English for Ivy Tech at night. She married her husband, Ross Wolfe, in the summer of 1991. They have two daughters, Katelynn 'Katie' Ann Meguschar, born in 1993, and Molly Elizabeth White, born in 1996.

When Katie began first grade in Beech Grove, Beth was thrilled to accept a position at Beech Grove Middle School so she could give back to this small-town community that gave so much to her. She taught a newly created communications course. During her 8 years at BGMS, Beth taught various English and math courses. After this, she accepted a position at Beech Grove High School as the English



department chairperson and teacher. When she moved to the high school, she also began coaching cheerleading as an assistant coach with Sheila Smith. She continued coaching for 7 years until her youngest daughter, Molly, graduated in 2014. Beth was able to have both of her children as students. She states, "Having my children as students and getting to know their friends better was just such a blessing." Beth has been very involved in the Beech Grove Schools and Community. She has sponsored the spell bowl team, National Honor Society, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, English academic team, and various other organizations. One of the things that makes Beth unique in education is that she has been in two different departments during her time at MSD Wayne Township and Beech Grove.

Both of Ross and Beth's daughters are teachers as well. Katie Meguschar is the English department chair at BGHS and teaches several advanced English courses. This is Katie's 9th full year of teaching. Molly teaches third grade at Blue Academy in Decatur Township and this is her 6th year teaching. Ross retired from teaching elementary school in Hamilton Southeastern in 2020 after spending 35 years in the classroom. Beth is excited to be able to join him in the fall of 2024 in also caring for the grandchildren.

Ross and Beth enjoy cruising and have spent the last 5 years cruising the Caribbean every chance they get. They also love going to Siesta Key, Florida, where they enjoy time with family on the beach. Beth enjoys reading and traveling when not teaching. Ross and Beth are actively involved in their church, Faith United Church of Christ on Thompson Road. They have been given so many wonderful opportunities and hope to continue to bless others with their God-given gifts in the years to come! She stated that she was so honored to be named as teacher of the year because she admires and looks up to the previous teachers of the year. She stated, "Those are some of my favorite teachers, and I am truly humbled to be listed among them." She will retire from Beech Grove City Schools at the end of this school year after 35 years of teaching to spend more time with her family and her grandchildren.

Beech Grove High School Alumni Association's 2024 Alumnus of the Year William (Bill) Boone Class of 1971

Bill was born June 1, 1953 to Thomas and Esther Boone. In 1958, the family moved to 310 North 16th Avenue, Beech Grove where he, along with his sister Becky and brother Bob were reared. They all attended Beech Grove schools. Bill graduated in 1971.

While attending high school, Bill worked in the Housekeeping Department at St. Francis Hospital. After graduating high school, he worked for Service Engraving preparing art work to be photographed for newspaper printing plates. He later worked at Wavetek and The Liberty Bell store. He also attended classes at IUPUI, and later in life, he attended Crossroads Bible College.

Bill started dating his classmate Paula Gossage when they were juniors at BGHS. Their first date was a bowling outing. Bill was somewhat surprised to learn Paula's dad owned the bowling alley. Even though she turned out to be a much better bowler than he was, he was smitten and the two were married June 10, 1972.

While growing up, Bill was able to observe the operations of the machine shop owned by his father. He worked for his dad from 1972 to 1988. After leaving there, he worked as a service engineer and machine programmer for Joachim Machinery.

Having worked in his father's shop for 16 years, Bill had gained the skills and knowledge (of the machining business) necessary to embark on a new business venture. In 1993, he and Paula formed W.T. Boone Enterprises. They sold that business in 2002 and in March of 2003, reopened in Franklin, IN. The business remains active with his wife and son as primary officers.

In 1999, Bill was a Charter Member of the Big Four Sertoma Club of Beech Grove. While serving in the Christmas project of 2000, Paula and Bill were collecting information for Christmas needs from families in Beech Grove and the surrounding areas. From their service with the Sertoma Club, they realized the desperate needs of local families, some of whom were going hungry without help.

Bill led the Thanksgiving food drive sponsored by the Club. He was touched in a significant way when he learned from Fire Chief, Dennis Buckley, the employees of A.D.M. Milling had a food drive and had collected a truck load of food. Chief Buckley entrusted Bill to make certain this food was distributed successfully.

That event changed his life forever. It was later in the year 2002, when Bill recognized he was being pursued by God to what he considers a higher calling. God gave him the courage to follow the teaching voiced by Jesus in Matthew 25:35-40 (shown below).

At the end of the holiday season, Bill was troubled realizing many organizations work diligently to serve the needy during the holidays; but when the holidays are over, the urgency seems to wane. With that concept weighing heavy on his heart, the idea of Servant's Heart was conceived, and in the summer of 2003, it became a reality.

In October of that year, with only \$2,000 to pay a building deposit and the first month's rent, and with only 100 pieces of food, it was with great faith and high hopes they planned to open the food pantry in November, 2003.

As word spread of Servant's Heart opening, many joined in to get them the food needed to be successful. Nancy Wilson, Bill's cousin, had made Melissa Keeley, Home School Advisor for South Grove Elementary, aware of the pantry's opening. She was in charge of a food drive that had collected more than 4,000 cans of food. All of these donations allowed the pantry to serve families from the very first day of active service and for months to come.

From 20 families being served on opening day in 2003, 20 years later the pantry serves approximately 180 families each week, with 500 families being served at Thanksgiving, and 200 families at Christmas. There are 24-36 volunteers serving regularly. Additionally, there are several part time volunteers including students from several high schools and colleges as they fulfill their community service requirements. During the Covid pandemic, the pantry was serving 240 families a week with services provided by a well-organized drive-thru system.

In addition to the food pantry, Servant's Heart now offers other services including furniture, clothing, and often domestic violence assistance. Servant's Heart has a Board of Directors consisting of 13 to 15 members from different walks of life. It serves the residents of an 8 zip code area. Regular providers to the Pantry are Beech Grove Wal-Mart, as well as the Thompson Road and Southport Road Kroger stores. Servant's Heart does buy some of their food from Gleaners and Meijer. Monies and additional contributions are received from supporting area churches, businesses, civic groups and individuals.

When asked, "When did you first feel led to become dedicated to serving others?" Bill states, it started at the age of 12 while attending church. When an invitation was extended to accept Jesus, he responded to the call and has been on that journey ever since.

Bill credits his teachers, Jim Flanders and Ron Melbert with pointing him in a purposeful direction. Mr. Flanders took him to the youth group at the Beech Grove Methodist Church and personally directed him in becoming a strong believer. Additionally, Bill mentions Dave Topping, head football coach; and Bill Baine, wrestling coach as being strong influences in his formative years. Bill was manager for both of those teams and played on the golf team during high school.

played on the golf team during high school. Bill's vision for the future of Servant's Heart includes offering employment opportunities, counseling services, donations to homeless camps, financial guidance, a thrift store and a worship center.

Bill hopes to be remembered by his desire for God to use him to guide people to Christ and show what change is possible when we maintain an ongoing relationship with God in our day-to-day walk; and, even more important to him, he strives to leave a Legacy from Jesus' teaching in the Gospel of Matthew 25:35-40 (paraphrased)

"I was hungry and you fed me, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger, and you welcomed me. I was naked and you clothed me. I was in prison and you came to me." They will ask "When did we see you hungry, thirsty, naked and in prison." Jesus will answer them, "Truly I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these, you did it to me."

From these verses came the mission of Servant's Heart: To share God's abundance and demonstrate Christ's love by serving the needs of families.

Bill loves and is dedicated to his wife of 52 years, Paula; their three sons; Mike, Jason, and Jon. Bill and Paula are also the proud grandparents of seven.
